Medical Assistant students benefit from a balanced blend of classroom and supervised clinical site training at local medical offices and clinics. All trainees receive “Skills for Success” instruction throughout their training period to enhance employment potential. Upon successful completion, students are recommended to take the California Certifying Board for Medical Assistants exam. This course also fulfills an entry requirement for the Vocational Nursing Program. ETR is able to fund many of our students for this program.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Adult students must:

- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Have valid California ID
- Have Social Security card or “Right to Work” in USA
- Submit online application
- Attend one mandatory orientation session
- Have no convictions and pass FBI and Department of Justice fingerprint clearance
- Pass drug screening, prior to acceptance
- TABE testing (if on-campus testing permitted)

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Adult students must:

- Bring record of “up to date” immunizations
- Pass a health examination
- Receive a TB clearance
- Be able to lift, bend/stoop, walk and stand as necessary for job duties
- Complete all items in Castle Branch Compliance Tracker

You must submit an on-line application at www.bashealth.org between April 19, 2021 to April 23, 2021. The application link will be closed after April 23, 2021. 22 students will be selected for this program each semester. Selection is based on testing and application. Interviews may be conducted as needed. Orientation will be mandatory for those students selected for the program.
